## **Our Infrastructure**

Our mission is to help the children grow mentally strong and physically tough. Our infrastructure includes:

#### **Water World**



Which is the first of its kind in any school of this country. To enhance the proper physical development through playful activities, the water world caters the need for the same for small children from Class LKG to III.

#### **Swimming Pool**



The school has a swimming pool which is half the size of Olympic swimming pool and is used for leisure activities and competition preparations for senior students.

#### **Indoor Stadium**

Highly spacious indoor stadium in which 1000 people can be accommodated. The stadium has a





basketball court, 4 badminton courts, 12 table tennis tables, a billboard and a pool table. It is also used for addressing various gatherings.

#### **Medical Centre**



We have highly trained and qualified doctors to take care of the children and staff. The medical centre is multi specialty centre for general practice, dentistry and ophthalmology. The medical centre receives consultation from specialized doctors of their fields.

#### Library

The school library is a continuous dynamic process which keeps on growing based on recent

Junior library has collection of 14000 books mostly fiction. Senior library has collection of over 30,000 books including reference, text, fiction and non fiction.

#### **Sports**

We have the best sports facilities in the whole country comprising of both indoor and outdoor



games. We have a mini golf course of 150 yards which was inaugurated by Ex-Chief Minister of J&K, Dr Farooq Abdullah in 2009. We have two cricket practicing pitches, basketball courts, volleyball and throwball courts.

#### **Practical Labs**

We have the best practical labs in the whole valley comprising of English Lab, Maths Lab, Physics Lab, Home Science Lab, Chemistry Lab and Biology Lab. Our labs are having facilities like audio-visual aids and slide shows for effective learning process. The English lab emphasizes to enhance the speaking and listening skills of the students of Delhi Public School Srinagar with 70 workstations and well equipped microphones.

#### **Central Heating**

The valley witnesses a tough and harsh winter. So to have a proper working atmosphere, the school is centrally heated, the first of its kind in the whole



country.

# First day of LKG students & their parents' orientation

The start of each school year represents new beginning for parents, teachers and especially students. At DPS Srinagar, our



goal is to prepare each child for the 21st century and this is done in partnership with the parents. Amidst all the learning, we are aware that we must provide ample opportunities for our children to be just.



On 21st March, 2011, it was a beginning of new era for some beautiful kids who came out from their homes / playschool into the world of reality to create niche for themselves in this beautiful world. The kids looked graceful in their fresh uniforms like penguins walking on snow. The environment of the school was full of emotions, some faces happy, nervous, anxious and enthusiastic. The school staff welcomed the toddlers and the school also organized an orientation cum interactive session on effective parenting skills for two days with LKG parents. The resource person for the program was Ms Ismat Ahmad who talked about physical, emotional and social development. The orientation program was a great success as 225 parents participated in the program.

## **Disaster Management Skills**

On 24th March, 2011, the emergency bell rang once, twice and thrice! Oh my God three times. All the students started



running towards their assigned paths to evacuate the building and assemble in the ground. In ten minutes, the whole school came out for safety purpose and realized it was an emergency





evacuation drill.

In this drill 2900 students and 123 teachers participated. DPS Srinagar conducts such emergency drills twice a year. The school has well planned exit paths which can be used in case of emergencies by the students and the staff.

#### **Academic Excellence**

Delhi Public School, Srinagar has always strived towards academic excellence and this year we again proved that our students can achieve good results.

We had 98.6% result in 12th class CBSE examination with 6 students scored above 90% and 40% students scored above 80%.

Iqra Altaf topped medical and non-medical streams with 96.6%. Sehar Manzoor topped medical stream with 93.4%. Abu Bakr topped commerce with 90%, Samrah Manzoor topped non medical with 88.6% and Anam Mushtaq topped Arts with 83.4%.

Our academic excellence was again proved by Class X with outstanding results. Out of 222 students, 32 scored 10 points and 67 scored 9 points on 10 point grading scale.

87 students of our school proved their mettle by qualifying various prestigious examinations.

52 students qualified for AIEEE, 12 qualified JKCET, 23 cleared the entrance examination of various medical colleges outside the state.

Our students proved that they can qualify at international level and six of our students got selected in various universities of USA. Mehak Jamal (Ex Student of DPS) received scholarship in Economics from Yale University, USA. Abdul Rabbani (Ex Student of DPS) got selected for Computer Engineering in the University of California, USA.

The story does not stop here at DPS Srinagar. We believe academic excellence is a continuous process and we try to strive from best to best.

### **Sports**

The students of DPS have taken part in all the sports activities be it Kho Kho or football, table tennis or badminton, cricket or basketball. The students have proved their excellence in adventurous sports like Taekwondo or Taegsodo.

The second State Taekwondo Championship was held at DPS in which 500 participants from 28 schools took part. DPS Srinagar bagged 17 gold, 15 silver and 11 bronze medals.

The biggest ever 7-20 tournament of the state







(KPL) was held for the first time in the school in which all the districts participated and winners got a price of 5 lacs.

The second interstate invitational Taekwondo Championship was held at DPS in which 458 participants from 9 different states took part.

DPS Srinagar also participated in National Taegsodo Championship at Maharashtra in which the school bagged 11 gold, 3 silver and 2 bronze medals.

A mega event U-19 T-20 Championship was held in September in our school in which two teams from South Africa and two from valley took part including DPS Srinagar.

In third GTK Tangsoodo International



Championship, DPS Sringar won 7 gold, 2 silver and 2 bronze medals.

DPS Students took part in marathons which were held on special days like Women's Day and special themes like 'Save Dal' and 'Keep Earth Green'.

One of our student Momin Manzoor was selected for U-14 National Cricket Camp brining laurels to the school by being the first student to achieve such a feat. Our students also participated in National Swimming Camp at Goa and received guidance from National level coaches in the school swimming pool.

In U-19 Girls Basketball tournament (CBSE Cluster XII 2011), DPS was runner up.

#### **Health Care Professionals**

For the first time in the valley, a team of world famous doctors visited DPS in collaboration with Medanta Medicity under the leadership of Dr Naresh Trehan, world famous cardiologist. A free medical camp was organized for children and their relatives. The team of doctors was comprised of world famous doctors like:


