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AIM,OBJECTIVE AND OUTCOME:

To know their mediums of ART

MARCH

CONTENT	a) Method of Drawing. Drawing Objects b) Classification of Pencils, colours etc. Free Hand Drawing: Drawing Shapes, Objects etc. c) Line and Tone: Drawing different types of lines, joining dots, lines to form shapes. Motor skills activity
AIM,OBJECTIVE AND OUTCOME	This helps the children to think more about the different lines and shapes to create their own imagination.

APRIL

CONTENT	Introduction before we begin our art work. Art material introduction with visit to senior Art-Room. Filling colours in different Shapes (<i>Outline concept</i>) Difference between Light and Dark. Using pencils and colours Light shade and dark shade. Motor skills activity
AIM,OBJECTIVE AND OUTCOME	Introduction and classification enable the children to understand their tools of art properly

MAY

CONTENT	Nature study 1) Natural objects: drawing of Leaves, Flowers
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	2) Drawing: Fruits. 3) Drawing Vegetables. Motor skills activity: paper collage of fruits/flowers
AIM,OBJECTIVE AND OUTCOME	Nature study widens the mantle ability and love for nature,

JUNE

CONTENT	Colour concept 1) Primary Colours (<i>Red, Blue and Yellow</i>) 2) Secondary colours (<i>Green, Orange and Violet</i>) 3) Filling colours either primary or secondary in a given object. Motor skills activity: 1) Overlapping of basic shapes and filling of colours
AIM,OBJECTIVE AND OUTCOME	This helps the children to learn how to make different colour shade by mixing primary colours.
