To know their mediums of ART

CONTENT	Method of Drawing. Drawing Objects Classification of Pencils, colours etc. Free Hand Drawing: Drawing Shapes, Objects etc. Line and Tone: Drawing different types of lines, joining dots, lines to form shapes. Motor skills activity
