CLASSES REQUIRED	8 periods
ΤΟΡΙϹ	Keyboard practice/song notations /Different Sargam Alankaars.
CONCEPT & SKILLS	Development of appropriate technical skills. Cognitive development while playing the piano. Building self-confidence.
LEARNING OUTCOMES	Children will learn how to accompany instrumental and vocal musicians. To develop knowledge and skills related to basic piano keyboard instruction including basic keyboard techniques and fingerings. Eye –hand coordination is developed while playing instrumental music.

CLASSES REQUIRED	8 periods
ΤΟΡΙϹ	Taal Dadra ,Taal Keharva / Group songs / Alankaars .
CONCEPT & SKILLS	Develop the techniques of patterns of Taal (Rhythm) with vocal songs. Concept of Dadra Taal /Keharva Taal. To know the importance of Taal in singing. Control of rhythm and time.
LEARNING OUTCOMES	To understand the importance of rhythm. Getting acquinted more and more towards instrumental music. Students will be able to play Dadra Taal and keharva Taal (Rhythm) on Congo. Correct hand setting on Congo. Learn to develop different patterns of Taal /Rhythm in singing.

PEDAGOGY	The teacher will practically show how to play Dadra Taal and Keharva Taal/Rhythm.
