TOPIC	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Alphabets X, Y, Z, A, M (print caps)
CONCEPT & SKILLS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Prepositions: on, in, inside, outside.• Action words: (clap, swim, give, take, pull)• Rhymes: The dog says bow wow. An elephant.• Skills: Listening. Speaking. Reading Writing. Recitation with proper actions. Vocabulary development.
LEARNING OUTCOMES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children will be able to understand the prepositions and action words.• They will be able to use the words in everyday English.• Developing rhythmic sense and body actions.• Join in choral refrains ie. Recitation.• Developing motor skills and eye-hand coordination.
INSTRUCTIONAL TOOLS & REFERENCES	Pencils, Crayons, worksheets, and notebook. Teacher Presenter.
PEDAGOGY	Learn on the spot game (prepositions). Follow up:

	<p>The teacher will make students learn prepositions through the activity as the students will be asked to keep their books on the table and say as The book is 'on' the table. Here teacher will stress on using 'on'.</p> <p>Similarly they will be asked to keep the book in the bag and say as The book is 'in' the bag.</p> <p>Action words:</p> <p>To make students learn action words teacher will perform the action together with them and learn accordingly eg; the teacher and students will clap their hands and say as clap.</p> <p>The teacher will ask them to pull.</p>
ACTIVITY / ASSIGNMENT / RESEARCH	<p>Prompting activity:</p> <p>Teacher will ask the students to dip the finger in the poster colour and draw different alphabets on the chart paper or newspaper.</p> <p>Alphabets: X, Y, Z, A, M.</p> <p>The teacher will take out objects from the magic bag related to the alphabets X, Y, Z, A, M. The teacher will name the objects and will stress on the first sound like (A) for Apple or Arrow.</p> <p>Follow up: Oral drill of phonetics will be followed by ppt.</p> <p>Oral drill in classroom.</p>
INFORMAL ASSESSMENT	<p>Fun based worksheet will be provided.</p> <p>Evaluating comprehension of alphabet and recognition of pictures.</p>
