	Q3. How do you define the terms Janpada and Mahajanpada?
	Q4. From where have we get the design of our national emblem?
	Q5. What are the sources that tell us about the early kingdoms?
	Q6. Who was the first empire of the Mauryan Dynasty?

	Certain textual questions will be discussed with the students related to the topics.

	Discussion session will be followed on various topics in which the students will be given a problem for discussion to present their ideas or views. • For Example, Imagine you live in Mauryan times. You have

	been made the king for a day. Discuss your experiences in the class.
